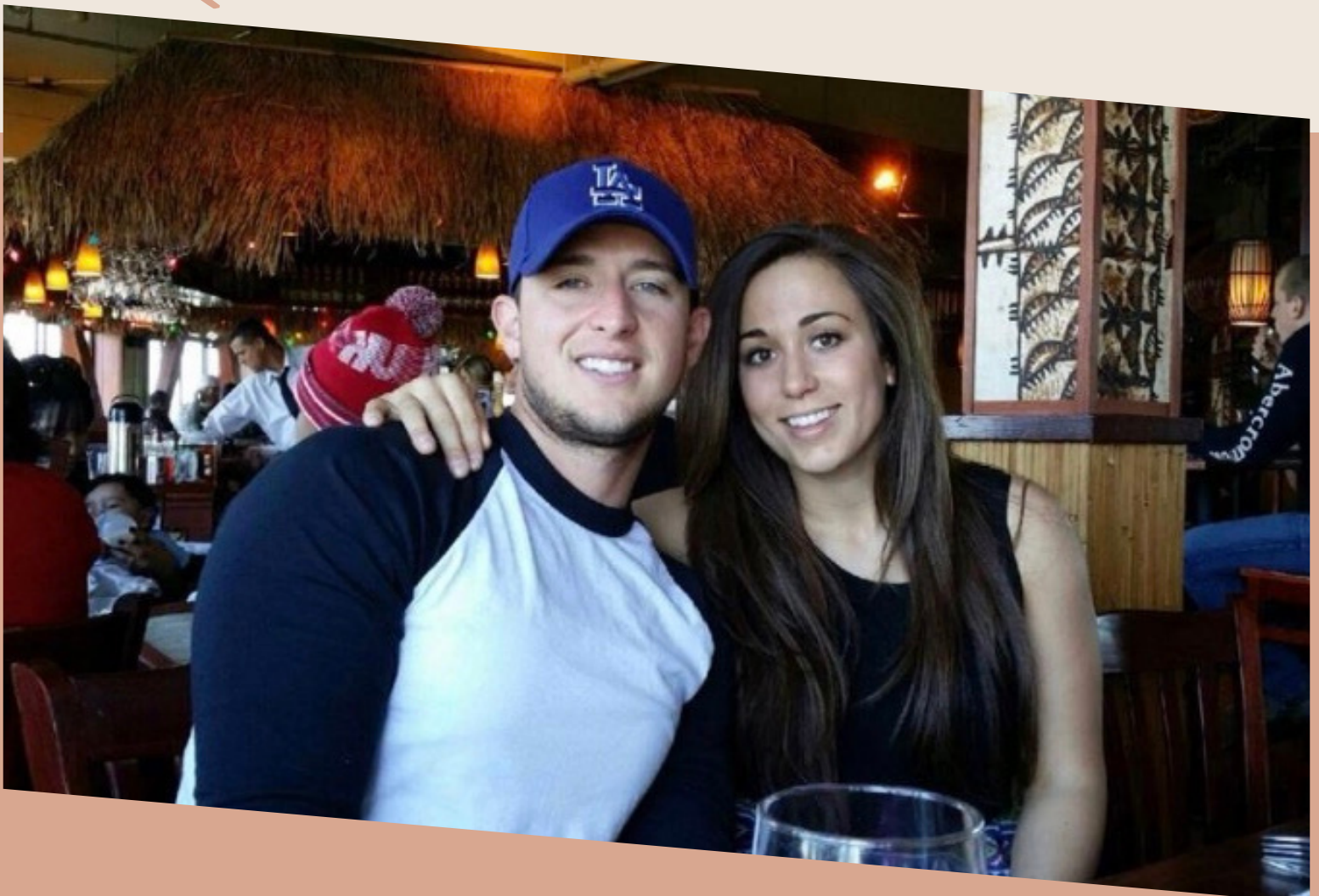

# Our Story

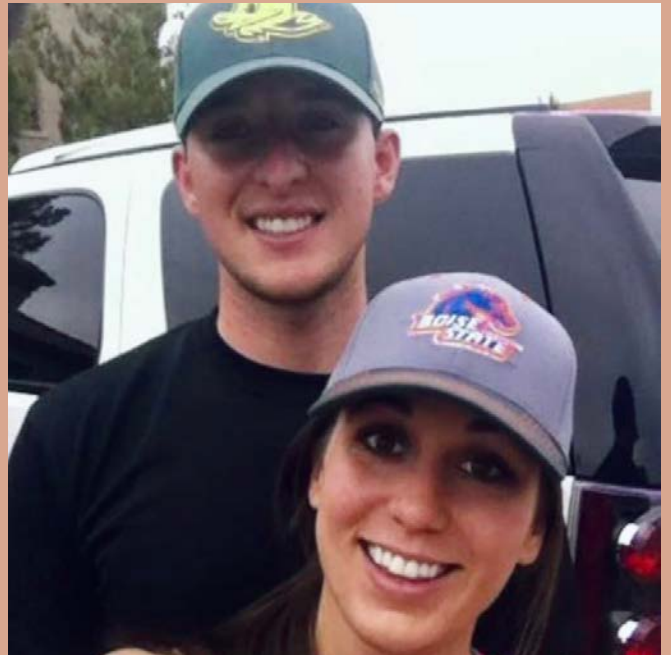

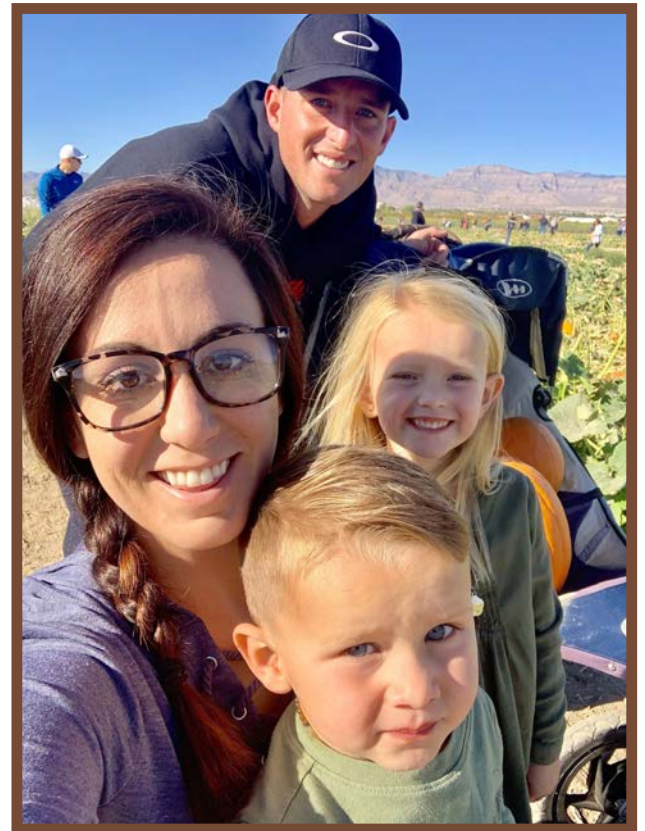
dedicated. - loving. - supportive
