ROSIE GIRL IS *pure sunshine.*

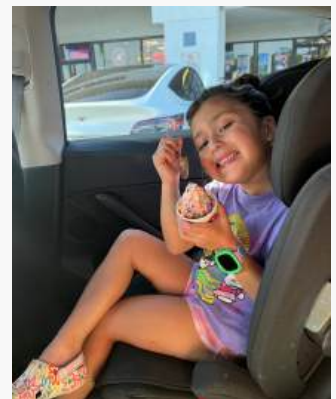

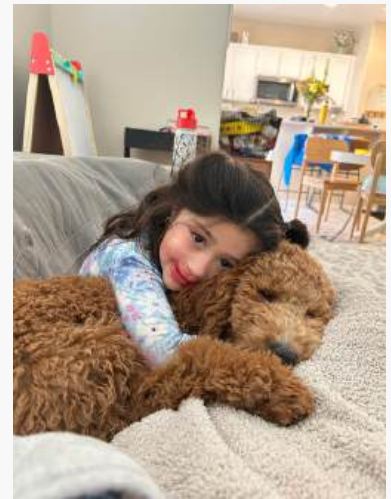
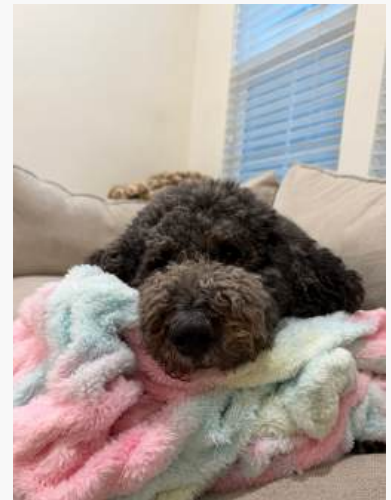
Adoption has always been the way we decided to grow our family.
