ABOUT *Trey*

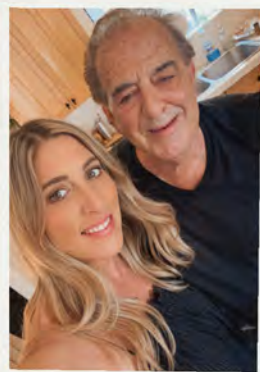
